

Combining these movements offer the widest possibilities of image control

These movements,

exceptionally generous for a 6.5 x 9 cm studio camera, make it possible to exploit to the full the 100° angle of the f/8,65 mm Super Angulon, even when coupled with the special soft bellows.

Tilt: 35° Swing: 65°




